In accordance with New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection Administrative Order 2021-25, Competitive Power Ventures, Inc. (“CPV”) will hold a public hearing for the purpose of receiving oral and/or written comments on its Title V Air Permit Renewal, current permit number **BOP210001** for the Woodbridge Energy Center, located at 1070 Riverside Drive, Keasbey, NJ. *This session will focus on the existing facility and is not related to the proposal for a new unit.* The hearing will be held via virtual attendance/Teams on **7/27/2022**, from 6:00 PM EST to 8:00 PM. CPV will also receive and consider written comments for 60 days. The written comment period will start on 6/27/2022 and will end at 5:00 pm on 8/27/2022.
